

Regulatory Ranking Rules

General rules

Each year, the EDU Commission awards 3 EDU Main Rankings and each organizing member country that hosts an EDU Main Ranking has the opportunity to host a National Ranking with international participation in the same season as it organizes the EDU Main Ranking.

Awarding of the EDU Main Rankings IDF/EDU Commission - Criteria

All Regular Affiliated Member Countries to the IDF may apply in writing edu@idfdarts.org to the IDF/EDU Commission for the organization of an EDU Main Ranking. The EDU rankings are only allowed to be held by member countries that have no liabilities to the IDF or its IDF/EDU Commission. Another criterion for the award is whether the organizers member country has registered a Champions League team for the season in which they hosted the ranking. In special cases, the evaluation catalogue from the last ranking of this member country may also be decisive. The organizer must meet the requirements of the ranking. In case of non-compliance with these rules, the following ranking will be withdrawn from the respective member country. In the event of a positive confirmation of the ranking by the IDF/EDU Commission, the organizer is therefore also the responsible organizer of the ranking and is responsible for all legal regulations, licenses as well as the allocation of expense contributions as well as all legal reports that are subject to this event.

In the case of an EDU main ranking (whole weekend), only IDF/EDU homologated dart machines may be set up in the entire tournament hall, sports hall, hall. In the tournament hall, including adjoining rooms, no advertising may be made for non-homologated dart machines. In the case of EDU main rankings, the IDF and EDU Commission has the right to use advertising space in the tournament hall for its sponsors free of charge, in consultation with the local organizer.

The implementing member country has to pay 250 euros to the IDF/EDU Commission for an EDU main ranking. Tournament announcements from the main rankings must be sent to the IDF/EDU Commission edu@idfdarts.org 2 months in advance.

An EDU main ranking must meet the following requirements:

The match dates of the Champions League will be assigned exclusively to the 3 main rankings.

Ranking Tournament Rules:

The warm-up on the Friday before the EDU ranking may not be played before 6.30 p.m. out of consideration for the arriving darts athletes from the neighboring countries. In the tournament hall, the tournament rules of the EDU, as well as the current EDU ranking rankings must be posted. The entry fee for the EDU tournaments may not be higher than for the Open tournaments. All EDU Tournaments Ranking & DYP as well as the award ceremony must be completed on Saturday. All participants must have a valid license from an affiliated member association of the EDU. It may be played on the small (13 inches) or large (15 inches, bull eye must be 25/50) disc.

The basic round is played best of 3 or best of 5 legs in a doubles ko system. The 8 best men (4 winners + 4 losers side) and the best 4 women (2 winners + 2 losers side) will then play in the play-off – knockout mode best of 3 sets – best of 5 legs. In the first round of the playoffs, the players from the losing side have a handicap of 0:1 in the sets. The players of the winning side draw their opponents from the losing side in the first round.

Players who have qualified for the Play of (8 men and 4 women) are not allowed to participate in the EDU DYP competition.

Double DYP Rules:

The registered players will be divided into strength groups by the tournament management. Registrations will be sorted by country and skill level. The strong gentleman must be assigned a weak gentleman or lady.

The EDU Rankings can be conducted on tournament schedules or through a tournament program. All results must be sent to EDU <u>edu@idfdarts.org</u> via email within 7 days of completion in Excel format (rank, player license, surname, first name, country and, in the case of DYP, the gender of the players in separate columns).

National Ranking Requirements:

National rankings may be made by each regularly affiliated member country to the IDF member country only once per season, provided that that member country also organizes an EDU main ranking during that season. The dates of the National EDU Ranking Tournaments must be announced to the IDF/EDU Commission at least 3 months in advance. The dates of the National Rankings may not overlap with the dates of the official tournaments of the IDF/EDU Commission. For a national ranking, the organizing member country has to pay 100 euros to the IDF/EDU Commission.

Game Mode National Ranking

The game mode is the responsibility of the organizer. An individual tournament (women and men separately) soft dart must be played. Points will only be awarded for one individual competition (women and men). Points will only be awarded to EDU licensed players. Scoring for ranking tournaments: (see appendix)

Scoring EDU Main Rankings as well as National Ranking

The European Championships men's and women's singles is the first ranking tournament of the season. The last tournament of the season is always the third EDU main ranking. Each player can collect a maximum of points from the following tournaments during the season. 1x European Championship Singles , 3x EDU Ranking, 3x DYP, 1x National Ranking

Expense Contributions EDU Final Ranking

The expenses of the EDU Final Ranking of the Ranking Tournaments will be paid by the IDF/EDU Commission. These expense contributions are transferred by the EDU Commission to the member countries whose licensed members are entitled to this expense contribution from the final ranking. Member countries can then hand over this expense contribution to their affiliated associations or Licensed Members. Always provided that the member country is entitled to this expense contribution, has no financial debts to the IDF or IDF/EDU Commission.
