



EDU Reglement Ranking Turniere

General rules

Each year, three major EDU rankings will be awarded. In addition, each affiliated association has the possibility to align a national ranking with international participation. The EDU main rankings will be awarded at least one year in advance.

The organizing association has to pay to the EDU € 250 for an EDU main ranking. For a national ranking, the organizing association has to pay € 100 to the EDU. The schedule of the main rankings must be sent 2 months in advance to the EDU (roger.volken@rhone.ch). The schedule of the national rankings must be sent at least 3 months in advance to the EDU (roger.volken@rhone.ch).

The dates of the national rankings may not overlap with the dates of the official tournaments of the EDU. The Champions League matches will be played exclusively on the 3 main rankings.

The allocation of EDU's main ranking according to the following criteria:

EDU rankings may deliver only associations that have no liabilities to the EDU.

The organizing association must register a team for the Champions League for the current season. In special cases, the catalogue of reviews from the last EDU Ranking of this association may be used.

The organizer must comply with the requirements of the catalogue of requirements. Failure to comply with these rules may not perform the following ranking of the respective association.

On a main ranking EDU (all weekend) may be placed only by the EDU homologated dartboards throughout the location. Throughout the location may not be advertised for non-homologated darts.

On EDU main rankings the EDU has the right to use for free advertising space in the tournament hall for their sponsors, in consultation with the host site.

Ranking tournament rules

The warm-up on Friday before the EDU-ranking may not be played before 6:30 p.m. in deference to the Dart players arriving from neighbouring countries.

In the tournament hall, the EDU-tournament rules, as well as the current EDU Ranking rankings must be published. The entry fee for the EDU tournaments may not be higher than in the open tournaments. All EDU Ranking Tournaments & DYP and the ceremony must be completed on Saturday.

All participants must have a valid license from an affiliated member association of the EDU. It can be played on the small (13 inch) or large (15-inch, bull eye has to be 25/50) board.

The EDU rankings can be written on official EDU tournament plans (can be obtained from the association at cost) and submit to the association or the tournaments are handled through a tournament program, which was approved by an EDU board member.

All results must be made within 7 days after the execution in Excel format (Rank, player's license, name, first name, country, and the DYP, the gender of the players in separate columns) via email to roger.volken@rhone.ch and info@css-dart.ch.

Penalty for failure to comply the 7 day period is € 250, - €.

D.Y.P. Rules:

The listed players are divided by the tournament administration in level groups. Registrations are sorted by country and skill level. A high-level man gets a lower-level man or a woman as a partner.

Requirements for national rankings:

The play mode determines organizer.

There must be played a single tournament (men and women separately) Soft tip.

Points will award only for **one** single event (men and women).

Points are awarded only to EDU licensed players.

Scoring for ranking tournaments – see attachment

The EC tournament single men and women is the first tournament of the EDU rankings (charts). The last tournament is always the 3rd EDU Ranking. The price giving for the final Ranking list will be at the following EC during the award ceremony on Friday

Tournaments category national open be organized by each EDU member only once during this period. National open tournaments can be only organized by a member they have registered a Champions League Team.

Every can player have as maximum points from 1x EC, 3x EDU Ranking, 3x DYP, 1x National open

Tournament System Cat. EDU Ranking

Basic part is played best of 3 (or 5 legs) DKO. 8 best men (4 right and 4 left side) and 4 best women (2 right and 2 left side) will continue play off using KO model best of 3 sets, best of 5 legs. First play off round only - players from the left have a handicap (they are losing by one set). The right side players will draw their opponents from the left.

Players from the play off can't play the D.Y.P. !

Evaluation of EDU ranking

Prize money will be paid at the European Championships for the first 30 men and first 30 ladies, according to the final ranking list, which participated at 2 rankings this season or at 1 ranking and the European Championship Ranking tournament.

Players they are in the standings of the 1-30 and did not meet the criteria are not eligible for the prize money.

Not picked up prize money at the European Championships remain in the EDU.

Qualifying exceptions can only decide the EDU board members
